### **21. Minutes**

It was resolved that the minutes of the Town Hall management Committee held on the 27<sup>th</sup> August 2008 be adopted.

### **22. Matters arising**

**Min 15** – Councillor Goldstone requested, and the committee agreed, that for future meetings a report on the income received from bookings be included as a standard item on the agenda.

The Chair of the committee, Councillor J A Bowen, would meet with the Town Hall Manager before the next meeting to review the charges for 2009 and report to the committee.

### **23. Use of Malting Hall**

A report was considered on the future use of the Malting Hall and the style of furniture considered suitable. It was resolved to RECOMMEND to the Town Council that the existing furniture is sold or otherwise disposed of and replaced with new, modular tables and chairs that would enable a more flexible layout for alternative uses.

### **24. Wall Decorations in the Town Hall**

The committee considered the content of a report on the subject of wall decorations within the Town Hall, including the location for the refurbished war memorials. It was RESOLVED that as few members of the committee had seen the finished restoration work the memorials would be displayed in the Malting Hall before a final decision was taken. The other wall decorations placed into storage during the work to the Town Hall would be examined and a recommendation made to the Town Council about their future.

The meeting ended without further discussion to accommodate the Extraordinary Town Council Meeting.
