MAJOR RESURFACING WORKS IN OCTOBER: HIGH STREET, GLOUCESTER ROAD AND ABBEY ROW

For three weeks from October 10th resurfacing work will take place in the Town Centre. Work will start at 6pm every weekday evening and will carry on until midnight. The High Street will be the first road to be resurfaced beginning at the bottom of the High Street and will carry on until midnight. It is hoped that the actual resurfacing will only take two weeks with the road marking being done in the third week.

The Town Council, together with a representative of the Chamber of Commerce, met with Wiltshire Highways during the summer to work out the timings. It is hoped that evening working will lead to a minimum of disruption. The roads in question have been in desperate need of work for some years and have been a major source of complaint to the Town Council.
