BC/23/03 Public question time in respect of items included in this agenda

BC/23/04 To approve Minutes of the meeting held on 26th October 2022

The minutes of the meeting held on the 20th July were approved as a correct record.

BC/23/05 To note income and expenditure report

The Income & Expenditure Report was noted. The Clerk was asked to action maintenance work that has been previously identified as soon as possible, there is an underspend in the Cemetery Maintenance code over £2000

BC/23/06 To consider expenditure for sealant for external walls of Chapel

Since the last meeting the Clerk has spoken to builders who stated that the damp issue was caused and exacerbated by the blocked down pipes and old shed. Both issues have now been rectified and the damp is no longer coming through.

It was resolved that all fees would be increased by 7.5%, to the nearest £5 or £0.

Cllr Ritchie reported that several graves with local interest have been researched by the group so far. The graves are plotted on the Explore Malmesbury App with some detail. Further information will be available at a future meeting

Correspondence from the Group was noted and it was agreed to plant seven Silver Birch Trees in the top left corner of the new extension to assist with 'softening' the boundary between the two areas.

Following discussion, it was agreed that between 1 and 2 announcements of upcoming activities and events per year would be required to include the work of the Cemetery Conservation group and approximately 1 issue per year would arise that would require a quick public response.
