

Temporary Road Closure Order Town Police Clauses Act 1847

IN ACCORDANCE with Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, which section gives Wiltshire Council ("the Council") the power to make an Order for roads within its administrative area to be closed temporarily to all vehicular traffic (and for alternative routes to be observed) for the purposes of preventing obstruction.

The Council HEREBY ORDERS

On: **Friday 02nd December 2022** between the hours of **16.00** and **22.00**

Purpose: **Late Night Christmas Shopping Event**

That the following roads and streets in the town of **Malmesbury** are to be closed (save in any case of emergency) to all vehicular traffic as set out below:

- a. **B4040 (Part) Triangle / Abbey Row / Gloucester Street / Oxford Street;** from its junction with Bristol Street to its junction with Cross Hayes;
- b. **B4040 (Part) High Street;** from its junction with Gloucester Street to its junction with Ingram Street;

Nothing in this Order shall prevent vehicles from proceeding in the said lengths of road when being used in connection with the event stated above.

AND it is also hereby ordered that appropriately sign posted diversionary routes will be in place throughout the period of closure.
