C&TP/22/93 To receive declarations of interest.

C&TP/22/94 To receive apologies.

C&TP/22/95 Public question time in respect of items included in this agenda

There were no public questions.

C&TP/22/96 To approve minutes of meetings held on the 13th October 2022

The minutes of the meeting were approved and signed as a correct record.

C&TP/22/97 To receive income and expenditure report

**C&TP/22/98** To consider quotes for reproduction of Walks Around Malmesbury (Report CM)

It was agreed that we will select the third supplier. Branding and logos to be added to the booklet and it would be helpful for a councillor to review the copy before it goes to print to copy-check.

C&TP/22/99 To consider holding an arts festival in 2023 and determine ways forward

### C&TP/22/104 To note Winter Support programme report and consider proposals (KP)

The report was noted, and that further work will continue in this area. The signposting of winter support may be part of the Mayors Newsletter which will be delivered to residents in January 2023.

# C&TP/22/105 To consider making a 2023/24 budget request to P&R to establish a formal PR and Comms role within MTC on a contract or employed basis (Cllr Wood).

It was agreed that the budget request for £12,000 (the estimation of one year's salary for this role) will be taken to P&R Committee to establish a formal PR and Comms role within MTC on a contract or employed basis.

## C&TP/22/106 To consider proposal to TH&F for extension/purchase of planters and seating provided by City Dressing (report LD).

It was noted that the Welcome Back to the High Street funding initiative has now finished and is being replaced by a new funding scheme and further details of this and how to apply will be sent by Wiltshire Council to the Town Clerk and this will be forwarded to C&TP Councillors.

It was agreed that the two wooden benches currently situated outside the Town Hall should be purchased by Malmesbury Town Council at a cost of £100 each (£200 in total) from City Dressing and we will request approval from Town Hall and Facilities Committee. Malmesbury Town Council will not be purchasing or retaining any other items from City dressing (currently items in Birdcage Walk which Dep Town Clerk will instruct to be removed).

### C&TP/22/107 To receive updated on current projects

Late Night Shopping – progressing well, volunteers will be required at the event.

Volunteer Event at Town Hall - Dep Town Clerk to look at dates to hold this, a Saturday in Feb/March/April and will utilise as many rooms as possible at the Town Hall, between 9 am and 5 pm.

Shopping bags – it was agreed by the committee we will not progress this item any further as it was thought the product would not meet required sales.

Communitea – This event has now evolved into an afternoon tea with refreshments and entertainment and also a pantomime in January 2023 to be held at the Town Hall. Celebrate Age Wiltshire will provide funding towards transport and refreshments. There is a budget amount of £200 for these events.

### C&TP/22/108 To note progression with projects 2023
