Bus Service Improvement

£2 fare cap on single tickets in place till 31st March 2023 as a government initiative and this applies to certain providers.

Health and Wellbeing Forum

Support and communication in place, and following successful Communitea event at Xmas a Pantomime is to be held at Town Hall in January and Celebrating Age Wiltshire will be contributing to entertainment and transport costs.

Malmesbury Climate Action Network (inc. Malmesbury Against Plastics)

Repair Café has returned and is well subscribed. Fruitful Malmesbury are developing new ideas, looking forward to open spaces projects. No recent updates from Malmesbury Against Plastics. It was noted there is a community heat loss camera which can be borrowed from a neighbouring parish (Sherston). Re-New Workshops in February 202 free of charge to inform on solar energies, air/heat sources pumps in the form of a presentation to share information etc.

FC/23/10

Wiltshire Council have published budget papers including a council tax rise from 1.99 % to 4.99%. It was noted that funding has been withdrawn to Visit Wiltshire and there may be others areas that impact MTC. It was agreed the budget and its impact should be reviewed at the next P&R committee meeting. New Localities Manager in post at Greensquare Accord and it was agreed to issue an invite on behalf of K Power (Mayor) for the new manager to attend the next Full Council meeting. There still remains a lack of clarity re 5-year housing supply and local plan. Pre-application for Abbey House will shortly be due, given the impact on the town and those resident living nearby it was agreed the Mayor would the encourage the applicants to offer a community engagement event to display the proposed works.
