Statement of Wiltshire Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders

RTRA 1984 Section 1 (1)

- (a) For avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;
- (d) For preventing the use of the road by vehicular traffic of a kind which, or its use by vehicular traffic in a manner which, is unsuitable having regard to the existing character of the road or adjoining property.

Order 1 – 20MPH Zone

The proposed reduction in the extent of the 20MPH Zone is to remove the overlap that currently exists with the 30MPH restriction governing the roads in Station Yard Car Park.

Order 2 – One Way Traffic

- i) The commencement point of the One Way Traffic Order is redefined to coincide with the position of the existing terminal signing.
- ii) The requirement in the Order to travel only in the permitted direction makes specific reference to **motor** vehicles, thus excluding cycles from the said requirement.

Order 3 - Width Restriction

- The commencement point of the Width Restriction is redefined to coincide with the position of the existing terminal signing.
- ii) The width specified in the restriction is reduced to reflect the measured width of the road passage across the bridge.
