4260	Change of priority of traffic flows requested at the junction of Abbey Row/ Bristol Street/ Gloucester Road, combined with the removal or carriageway restrictions.	

5602	Concerns expressed over the size of vehicles through Parklands linked to excessive traffic speed in a predominantly elderly populated area.	Weight limit signs at entrance to Malmesbury being reviewed.
7-20-7	Drop kerb request adjacent to Malmesbury Fire Station.	Approval from Royal Mail received to move the post box. Construction programmed for 6 th Feb. Post meeting moved to April.
7-23-01	Malmesbury, Cross Hayes car park. Request for disabled parking space to be allocated adjacent to 'Imperial hearing'	GG to investigate two existing disabled bays nearby and discuss with 'Imperial Hearing'.
7-22-14	Malmesbury – Market Lane Request to remove 'no entry' sign at Oxford Road and install bollards to enable Market Lane to be pedestrianised.	Alternative option of planters put forward. To be CLOSED
