Parks and Open Spaces Report

1. **Dog Fowling Filands** – there is an issue with dog fouling in Filands view and Carnival close, reported to the Town Clerk by a resident on the 17th December. The fouling is on private land in front of the properties. The resident would be supportive of putting up a sign on their front lawn, for a specified period of time, along with at least eighteen other residents; if the Council could provide some signs.

Additionally, at the request of the Town Clerk, Wiltshire Council's Dog Control and Animal Welfare Officer visited the roads on the 8th January and erected the necessary signage.

2. **St Aldhelms Gym** – the gym 'presence' seems to have settled. A resident, local to St Aldhelms mead, who has started using the gym has contacted the Town Clerk to suggest the laying of mats between the gym items to mitigate against the mud, which has proven to be transferred onto the equipment resulting from wet weather. The Committee is asked to consider this suggestion.
