Market Cross Planters -The Town Clerk reported clarification had been obtained from Wiltshire Council Highways who confirmed a Section 19 permit would be required if planters (or part of) were situated on the highway. Wiltshire Council Conservation officer raised the need to ensure the planters were of sufficient size to act as a buffer, and designed in a way that ensured sufficient drainage so as not to cause moisture damage to the masonry.

 Parking Enforcement – The Town Clerk reported that the Council were prevented take on parking

 enforcement by the Traffic Management Act 2004. Cllr Jones requested a letter be sent to Wiltshire Council

 requesting greater level of parking enforcement service.
