Parking issue, 2 cars parking over one space is blocking an entrance. Refer to LHFIG, with completed form.

Correspondence was received 22/9/22 advising it was not possible to include our suggestions in the street naming for the Backbridge development. Cllr Exton will discuss with Cllr Jones, it was noted this issue had been passed to Cllr G Grant to raise at Wiltshire Council Cabinet meeting.

PE/22/133 Parklands Traffic Survey

Following this survey, Wiltshire Council will review the findings of a considerable number of large vehicles in this location on completion of a Highways Improvement form, which Cllr Exton will complete.

PE/22/134 EV Vehicle Charging Points

It was noted we have completed the survey by Wiltshire Council and we await contact regarding our next steps.

PE/22/135 Planning Appeals

It was reported that the Park Road appeal has been passed by the Planning Inspectorate.

PE/22/136 To consider entering into a funding agreement with Wiltshire Council for the suspension of car park charging commencing 01 October 2022 to 30 September 2023: first two hours of a stay at Station Road and free parking on bank holidays to Station Road and Cross Hayes parking area (Costing from Wiltshire Council - £9478.00).

It was resolved that Malmesbury Town Council will enter into the funding agreement as above. With £8000 in budget, the additional £1478 will be allocated from the Strategic Planning Fund. An extension was agreed with Parking Services to 15th October 2022 due to the delay in receiving the costing from Wiltshire Council.

Standing Item Report: to receive an update on the items listed

PE/22/136 Relocation of War Memorial

It was agreed to direct this item to Full Council for approval. If approved, the next stage, would involve a public consultation and costing.

PE/22/137 Abbey Mill Bridge

The Conservation Officer has requested the stonemason make up a sample board displaying the mortar, local stone etc and this is currently in progress.

PE/22/138 Market Cross

Cllrs Exton and Campbell attended an online meeting with Andrew Tubb from Cirencester Town Council. Further correspondence has been received by Cllr Exton from Mr Fox. It was agreed we are in the early stages of our enquiries and we will revert to Mr Fox when we have collated further information.

PE/22/139 St Aldhelm's Bridge

We await further information regarding property owners approval to these flood defenses along their boundaries.
