Signage in Cloister Gardens

- 1. Purpose of the report
- 1.1 To inform the committee of a request to install appropriate signage in Cloister Gardens
- 2. Background
- 2.1 The area of space known as Cloister Gardens is leased to the Town Council on a long lease from the owners of Abbey House.
- 2.2 The owner of Abbey House has requested that signs be positioned within the gardens in an attempt to reduce the instances of anti-social behaviour.
- 2.3 At times the area has proved to be an attractive location enabling a range of activities to be undertaken, some causing disturbance to quiet enjoyment.
- 2.4 It has been suggested that these incidents have been increasing and the local Police Community Support Officer has requested that signs be placed within the gardens discouraging loitering.
- 3. Proposals
- 3.1 The area does fall within the area of the Town subject to the bylaws aimed at banning drinking alcohol in public places.
- 4. Financial implications and risks
- 4.1 Notices were installed when the bylaws were first introduced but a recent audit has shown that several have been removed.
- 4.2 The replacement of appropriate notices would enable action to be taken by the police.
- 5. Recommendations
- 5.1 Members are requested to note the report and instruct the Town Clerk on the action to be taken.
