Additional River Walk Signage

1. Purpose of the Report

- 1.1 To notify the Committee that many tourists & new residents in Malmesbury frequently ask residents of Burnivale directions to the River Walk

2. Background

- 2.1 Although maps are available in the Information Centre, people often see the river from Abbey Row but having gone down into Burnivale are unsure of which direction to follow next.
- 2.2 An example of signage recently used for the new public toilets;



- 2.3 Two signs are suggested, one at the bottom of Betty Geezers Steps and another on the wall by the Maltings with the wording "River Walk" & a directional arrow.

3. Financial implications and risks

- 3.1 The price for a sign similar to the image as follows;
The total cost of a 300mm x 100mm slate sign will be £52.68 including delivery
The total cost of a 400mm x 150mm slate sign will be £96.98 including delivery
- 3.2 Permission might need to be sought for the siting of the signs

- 4.1 Members consider the report and determine a course of action.
