CE&TP/24/45 To receive declarations of interest.

None received.

CE&TP/24/46 To receive apologies.

Apologies received from Cllr Smith.

CE&TP/24/47 Public Question Time in respect of items included on this agenda.

CE&TP/24/48 To approve minutes of meeting held on the 11<sup>th</sup> April.

The minutes were approved and signed as a correct record. It was agreed that book tokens would be purchased to the value of £55 as prizes for the D-Day Poetry

Competition.

CE&TP/24/49 To receive income & expenditure report.

Report noted. Further funds are due from Barn Owl Books, Caerbladon & the Museum for sales of Devereux Souvenir Brochures. Expenditure in 4243 (Promotional Activities & Marketing) weas queried, the Town Clerk will forward breakdown to all members.

It was also noted that 4087 expenditure should have been carried over from last years'

budget and that St Aldhelm's Day expenditure is yet to show.

CE&TP/24/50 To receive TIC report.

Members noted the report. It was evident that during the Devereux weekend, visitor numbers were increased which would have also had a beneficial impact on all food

establishments in town.

It was agreed that the TIC review should take place at the earliest opportunity.

CE&TP/24/51 To consider report from CIIr D'Arcy on display of commercial leaflets in the TIC.

It was agreed that TIC staff will contact all places to eat and places to stay in the area to request leaflets/flyers to advertise their offering and that space would be provided on

a 'first come, first served' basis.

CE&TP/24/52 To consider convening meeting with relevant Committee at Tetbury Town Council and other stakeholders with a vested interest in Tourism in the South Cotswolds.
