PE/25/111 To resolve comment -planning application PL/2025/03305 Pittville, Bremilham Road Full planning permission – amended plans/additional information

Members of the public involved with the application provided background including liaison with Wiltshire Council for preapplication advice, amendments made to date and taking guidance from a Highways Consultant.

Members of the public were invited to speak. Residents in neighbouring properties voiced concerns including parking, access and egress, privacy, loss of amenity, overdevelopment of the site.

It was resolved to Object due to overdevelopment of the site and parking concerns. (The developer has made a parking allocation of 2 spaces per property. Wiltshire Council publishes a requirement of 3 spaces for the proposed type of property and we concur with this.)

A member of the public was invited to speak and raised concerns that the archaeological dig will put the trees at risk of irreparable damage and that many residents share these concerns. It was resolved to Support the application and request that weather conditions are taken into account when scheduling the works to minimise any detrimental effect to the tree roots.
